Encouragement from the Council Joe Loizzo, June 17, 2020

I was reflecting on several of the prophecies that we have received recently in our Zoom Praise and Worship meetings. There seems to be a definite theme. The Lord wants us to keep in mind that He has a plan for our future! He is with us and wants us to keep our eyes fixed on Him, and in doing so to rely on the Holy Spirit to provide sustenance for us and guidance for us no matter what the future brings.

"...according to my plans you should prepare for the future. My plan is the best plan for you. Seek my word, seek my will, seek my way. For I am with you; I will guide you and I will bless you. "

"Many are wondering, 'Is this a sign that the end of the world is near?' Do not be concerned about the future. Be only concerned about today. I have never called my people to wait or worry or wonder. Seek me and ask what it is that I am calling you to do during this time.

God's plan for us is always perfect, always the best thing for us because He loves us so much and wants only what is best for us. He wants to bring us closer to Him each and every day and His plans for our life will bring us happiness and peace, even though sometimes we don't immediately see that. The Lord is telling us to seek Him, asking Him what He is calling us to do during this time. It is a great question, and one which we must reflect on individually and as a community. What is God calling us to do now in these troubled and uncertain times? Another way to look at this question is, "What is His Mission for us as a community as we look towards the second half of 2020 and into 2021?". We don't often talk about "mission" but I think this word applies to our situation now more than ever before. What specific gifts and talents do we have as a community to use for God's work in the Ohio Valley now, to help people come to know Jesus, to build up people who already know Him, and to prepare people for whatever the future holds as we heard in the 1976 prophecy given by Fr. Mike Scanlan and explained by Ralph Martin last week. These are things I believe that we need to pray about and talk about so that we can hear the Spirit together and do whatever God asks us to do.

Pray to the Holy Spirit for a new outpouring of the Spirit in our lives for the new tasks that he will ask us to do in the days ahead!
